

# CHMS DRESS CODE

**NOTICE!**  
Information you must  
know & follow

The dress code will be **STRICTLY** enforced! Student's clothing shall be worn appropriately!

See student planner for details on School Board Dress policy

- No visible skin 4 inches/ finger tip length above the knee when wearing shorts, skirts, dresses, or ripped clothing.
- PANTS SHALL BE WORN SECURELY AT THE WAIST!
- Hats and other head coverings, including hoods, bandanas and beanies, are to be removed when indoors.
- No bare midriffs or blouses that are too short. Blouses **MUST** be long enough so that they could be tucked in and stay tucked in.
- No wallet chains, dog collars or spiked jewelry.
- No clothing which is offensive to good taste or which advertises tobacco, alcohol or drugs.
- No visible tanktops, spaghetti straps, or cami straps permitted.
- No leggings/jeggings/tights are allowed to be worn as pants.

Any student in violation of the dress code will be brought to the office and **REQUIRED** to contact parent for a change of clothes. Repeated violations of the District School Board of Pasco County Dress Code will result in disciplinary consequences.
