## CHMS DRESS CODE

Information you must know & follow

The dress code will be STRICTLY enforced! Student's clothing shall be worn appropriately!

See student planner for details on School Board Dress policy

- No visible skin 4 inches/ finger tip length above the knee when wearing shorts, skirts, dresses, or ripped clothing.
- **M** PANTS SHALL BE WORN SECURELY AT THE WAIST!
- Mats and other head coverings, including hoods, bandanas and beanies, are to be removed when indoors.
- Mo bare midriffs or blouses that are too short. Blouses MUST be long enough so that they could be tucked in and stay tucked in.
- Mo wallet chains, dog collars or spiked jewelry.
- ☑ No clothing which is offensive to good taste or which advertises tobacco, alcohol or drugs.
- ☑ No visible tanktops, spaghetti straps, or cami straps permitted.
- ☑ No leggings/jeggings/tights are allowed to be worn as pants.

Any student in violation of the dress code will be brought to the office and REQUIRED to contact parent for a change of clothes. Repeated violations of the District School Board of Pasco County Dress Code will result in disciplinary consequences.
