iPad- Room 110: We will begin our second cohort of iPad students for the Class of 2019. The iPad program is a one to one program in which students use their iPad for almost all learning experiences. Attend this session to learn more about how this program enhances student engagement and learning. Students must complete the online application to be accepted into this program.

AVID Program-Room 118: AVID, Advancement Via Individual Determination, is a college readiness program that is designed to teach students academic and social skills to help them develop habits and behaviors needed to succeed in rigorous curriculum. Students participate in the AVID elective as a support for their other courses. An application is required to be accepted into this program.

NJROTC-V2: NJROTC focuses on transforming today's youth into tomorrow's leaders. Cadets learn structure and self-discipline in an environment that strengthens character and perseverance.

Pasco eSchool and the On Campus Lab- Room 214: Our Virtual Instruction lab offers students an opportunity to take courses online with access to computers on campus during their school day.

Advanced Placement Program-Room 118: AP is in internationally recognized college-level curriculum taught in high school. 9th Graders can take AP Human Geography as a Social Studies elective.

Health Academy and Biomedical Program-Media Robotics Academy-V3
